PROCULTHER CONSORTIUM

The Italian Civil Protection Department (Italy), as Consortium leader, and the Ministère de l'Intérieur - Direction Générale de la Sécurité Civile et de la Gestion des Crises (France), the Ministry of Culture and Tourism of the Regional Government of Castilla y Leon (Spain), the Ministry of Interior - Disaster and Emergency Management Authority - AFAD (Turkey), the International Centre for the Study of the Preservation and Restoration of Cultural Property (ICCROM) and the Fondazione Hallgarten - Franchetti Centro Studi Villa Montesca.

BACKGROUND

Recent emergencies in Europe and worldwide have stressed the urgency to protect and increase the resilience of cultural heritage assets against the devastating impact of both natural and man made hazards. The project, co-founded by the Directorate-General for European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations of the European Commission-DG ECHO, promotes the development of preparatory measures in the framework of the Union Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM) for the protection of cultural heritage in case of emergencies.

PURPOSE

PROCULTHER aims at contributing to develop UCPM and Participating States capacities to protect cultural heritage assets during emergencies by placing their protection at the top of national European agendas and making the enhancement of their resilience a multi-sectoral and multi-stakeholder goal.

TIMELINE AND BUDGET

PROCULTHER will run from January 2019 to December 2021 with a budget of ϵ 799.076.
